General:

Each recipient will receive a Lions Hall of Fame lapel pin, a plaque, and their name permanently engraved on a wall plaque. The wall plaque will be displayed at the Lions State Headquarters Building.

NOMINATIONS:

1. Each District Chairman is responsible for the soliciting/completion of nominations and fees from the respective district.
2. Review the nomination(s) for accuracy and forwarding to the Lions Headquarters.
3. Qualifying nominations will be reviewed for guideline compliance, by the Hall of Fame Committee, and selections approved. Only 2 nominations may be sent in by each district.
4. Each nomination with a \$150.00 fee must be submitted in accordance with the guidelines criteria attached.
5. The fee will be used to provide a Lions Hall of Fame Lapel pin, a plaque engraved with the name. The program is to be maintained from the application fee.

MULTIPLE DISTRICT 12 TENNESSEE LIONS HALL OF FAME" CRITERIA

NOTE: Club must be "In Good Standing" with District and International dues paid up to date for the candidate to be considered.

NOTE: To be considered for induction into the MD-12 Tennessee Lions Hall of Fame, the candidate must be an active Lion with at least 15 years of service (exception for health reasons or death) with at least five (5) years of service in a MD-12 Lions Club in good standing.

Use the following format and application to submit your Club's "LIONS HALL OF FAME" candidate.

Complete your club's entry form in detail and mail it to your District's Honors Committee Representative (POST-MARKED NO LATER THAN JUNE 30.) Include a small picture of your candidate (color print is acceptable) if at all possible.

Attach additional pages with the information specified in items 1 & 2 below. No additional pictures or letters of recommendation will be considered.
