General:

Each recipient will receive a Lions Hall of Fame lapel pin, a Hall of Fame award, and their name permanently engraved on a wall plaque. The wall plaque will be displayed at the Lions State Headquarters Building.

Hall of Fame Nominations:

1. Each District Representative is responsible for the soliciting/completion of nominations and fees from the respective district.

(Note: There is not an HOF representative from 12-N. 12-N nominations will be forwarded to HOF Chair until a 12-N representative is found.)

2. Review the nomination(s) for accuracy and forwarding to the Lions Headquarters.

3. Qualifying nominations will be reviewed for guideline compliance, by the Hall of Fame Committee, and selections approved. Only 2 nominations may be sent in by each district.

4. Each nomination with a \$150.00 fee must be submitted in accordance with the guidelines criteria attached.

5. The fee will be used to provide a Lions Hall of Fame Lapel pin, an award, and the engraving. The program is to be maintained from the application fee.

NOTE: Club must be "In Good Standing" with District and International dues paid up to date for the candidate to be considered.

NOTE: To be considered for induction into the MD-12 Tennessee Lions Hall of Fame, the candidate must be an active Lion (exception for health reasons or death).

Complete your club's entry form in detail and mail it to your District's Honors Committee Representative (POST-MARKED NO LATER THAN JUNE 30.) Include a small picture of your candidate (color print is acceptable) if at all possible.

Attach additional pages with the information specified in items 1 & 2 below. No additional pictures or letters of recommendation will be considered.
